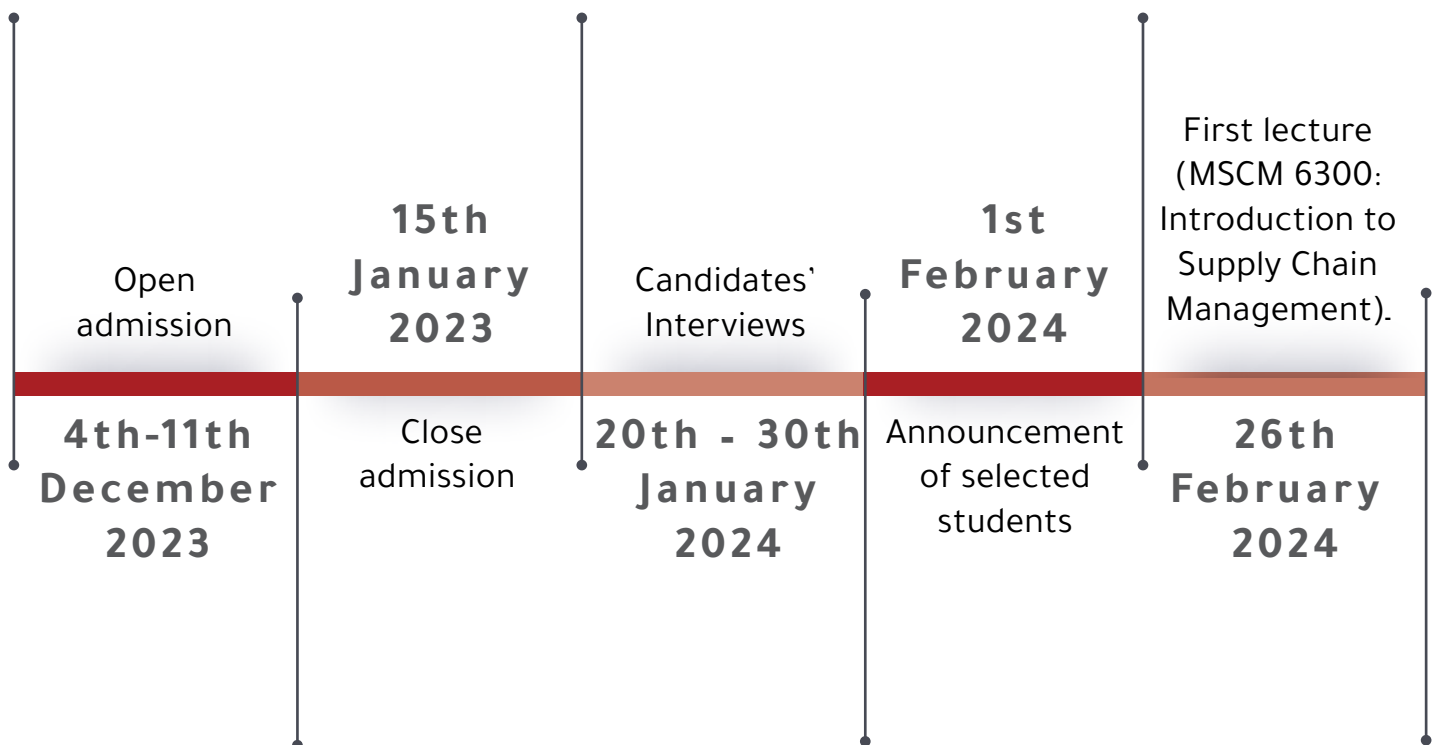


How to Apply?
