The Palestinian Forum for Medical Research (PFMR), in conjunction with the Faculty of Pharmacy, Nursing and Health Professions at Birzeit University, is organizing "The Eighth Annual Biomedical Research Symposium." This year, the PFMR will host renowned international scientists from the City of Hope Comprehensive Cancer Center (https://www.cityofhope.org), in California, who will be coming to recruit students who desire to pursue their graduate degrees in the USA. The ultimate goal of the symposium is to present research conducted by Palestinian students and researchers and bring together young and hopeful scientific minds.

We cordially invite you to present your work either by giving a presentation or presenting a poster. For those who wish to participate, please submit your abstract by January 20, 2019. Researchers will be informed of the acceptance of their abstracts no later than March 1, 2019. Students have the option to submit abstracts for consideration for oral or poster presentation. Abstracts from all areas of biomedical research are accepted, with a strong emphasis on cancer biology.

The purpose of the abstract is to enable the Scientific Committee to make an informed decision on the suitability of the proposed presentation for the symposium program and provide participants with a summary of the work presented.

Guidelines for Preparation of Abstracts

Title: The title should be in bold, uppercase letters with no full stop at the end

Authors: Names of authors should be in Times New Roman, size 12 fonts, as first name and surname with no full stop. Underline the name of the corresponding author. Author names should be separated by a comma. Where authors are from a number of different institutions, the appropriate institution number from the affiliation list should be given as a superscript number immediately after each author's name. Use an asterisk (*) to indicate the presenting author.

Affiliations: Affiliations should include department, institute, town and country. Where there are multiple affiliations, each should be listed as a separate paragraph. Each institute should appear in the order used when listing the names of the authors and show the appropriate superscript number.

Emails: The emails of the corresponding and presenting authors must be included.

Body of the abstract:

- Authors must submit a regular abstract (not structured), using the template below.
- Should not be more than 400 words.
- Please use Times New Roman, size 12 fonts and single line spacing.
- Greek and other special characters may be included. If you are unable to reproduce a particular special character, please type out the name of the symbol in full.
- Web links (URLs) should be provided in full, including both the title of the site and the URL, in the following format: Mouse Tumor Biology Database [http://tumor.informatics.jax.org/cancer_links.html]. Also include the date of access
- Abbreviations should be used as sparingly as possible.

References: In-text citations should be kept to a minimum. When inserted, in-text citations must be numbers between square brackets [1]. At the end of the body of the abstract, a separate section entitled "References" must be added where referring articles are included (see template for format).

THE TITLE OF YOUR ABSTRACT MUST BE WRITTEN IN BOLD AND CAPITALIZED LETTERS
