<u>Abstract</u>: Model theory is a branch of mathematical logic. It is concerned with studying mathematical structures such as groups, rings, orders, and graphs using formal logic. The term 'model' in model theory stands for a structure which satisfies a collection of properties expressed using a formal language. For instance, any group is a model of the axioms of groups. In this talk, I will give a brief introduction to model theory, and discuss one line of research in the field which studies 'homogeneous' structures.
