About the Organizer	State Academy of Forestry Administration (the former Beijing Forestry Management Staff College), established in1983, is a training institution under the State Forestry Administration. It provides training opportunities for civil servants and other employees of the State Forestry Administration, leaders from the counties where the key forestry programs are implemented, local forestry leaders and technicians, leaders of large and medium-sized forest enterprises, international trainees and key foresters. The Party School and Adult Education Research Center of the State Forestry Administration as well as China Forestry Education & Training Website are stationed in the Academy.
