Our planet has been facing major challenges in the post-development era and that called for crises intervention to address them. The plan for doing so was called the "Economic Development Plan (Plan A)." However, this plan has not been able to solve the problems of the planet and its populations, and thus exacerbating these problems. The international community, under the supervision of the United Nations, began to implement a new plan called "Sustainable Development Plan" (Plan B). This plan differs from its predecessor in focusing equally and in parallel on


economic, environmental and social dimensions. The United Nations, together with the world's countries

and the research community, work relentlessly to achieve progress on the implementation of sustainable development goals (SDGs) 2030 and to overcome the challenges that face achieving them. Furthermore; the UN, however, tries hard to follow up on the progress of the implementation of these goals. It is worth mentioning that these challenges are more difficult when we talk about countries and societies living under crisis, war, post war, and occupation, such as in

Palestine. Such countries and societies suffer from lack of resources as well as a real threat to the environment, caused by crises, wars, and the absence of strategic planning, in addition to complicated social circumstances due to the increasing numbers of causalities and injuries caused by war and the huge number of refugees fleeing their countries and the damage to basic services such as education and health. Therefore, this conference aims at shedding light on the opportunities and challenges of achieving the SDGs 2030 under conditions of war and crisis, in light of the increasing need to diagnose problems and propose suitable solutions that help countries and communities concerned and achieve the principle of "leaving no one behind".

OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE:

- Attracting local and international academics to discuss, evaluate and analyze various policies and plans to achieve the 2030 global sustainable development goals in exceptional situations and circumstances such as occupation and conflict.
- Providing policy makers with the opportunity to discuss the challenges facing the implementation of these objectives, SDGs 2030, their surrounding environment, and the societal conditions that constitute the environmental context for these objectives.
- Evaluating the efforts of the Palestinian government in achieving SDGs 2030 under occupation.
- Comparing efforts to achieve sustainable development policies at the national level with those undertaken at the local level in times of crisis.
- Promoting partnership in the formulation and implementation of sustainable development policies between different levels (local / regional / global).
- 6 Highlight the most important challenges and environment surrounding crises facing the implementation of SDGs 2030.
- Demonstrating the importance of integrating the theoretical dimension of sustainable social, economic, and environmental development with the practical dimension. This is one of the main objectives of the Conference
- Providing a platform for sharing experiences and lessons learned in the field of achieving and sustaining development concerning crises conditions.
