Dr. Ali Sabatin is an infectious disease (ID) specialist who completed his ID fellowship in 2012. He is board certified in ID from the Palestinian Medical Association. Dr. Sabatin has been actively involved in establishing an antimicrobial stewardship in Palestine. At the national level, Dr. Sabatin is well recognized as a leader in the field of infection control, standardization of diagnostic microbiology testing and building cumulative antibiograms. He is a major promotor of rational use of antibiotics in Palestine. AT AVH, Dr. Sabatin assembled the first dynamic antimicrobial stewardship team, build several antimicrobial dispensing guidelines according to the AVH antibiogram for empiric therapy and for preoperative antibiotic prophylaxes. The AMS team Dr. Sabatin built at AVH is being used as a model to help other medical institutions in Palestine build their own AMS teams.
