Nader Jalal is the founder and director of the Palestinian Institute for Cultural Development – Nawa. Nawa's prime research focusses on the musical renaissance in Palestine during the first half of the 20th century, building an archive of Palestinian classical music and reproducing the compositions of forgotten Palestinian musicians. Nader Jalal held the position of Director General of Arts and Music at the Palestinian Ministry of Culture, and Director General at the Supreme Council for Education and Culture. He has lectured locally and internationally on the Palestinian musical scene pre-Nakba and has contributed a chapter to the book

Palestinian Music and Song: Expressions and Resistance Since 1900 published by Indiana University Press.

He lives and works in Ramallah, Palestine.
