The world community, through the Conference of Parties (COP21), the countries that ratified the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change, have committed itself to keep a global temperature rise, this century, well below 2 degrees Celsius. To achieve this, COP21 called for zero net greenhouse gas emissions GHG to be reached during the second half of the century. The state of Palestine has joined the world community in ratifying the agreement and has developed a plan to reduce its carbon footprint mainly from electricity generation.

This Seminar will provide a broad overview of the sources of GHG and will discuss the various available technologies (solar, wind, geothermal, etc..) to reduce it. The talk will also touch on the options for Palestine and what the future is likely to look like in terms of renewable energy.

This seminar will be of interest to engineering professionals and students in various Engineering degrees.
