


To all Alumni and Former students of Birzeit college.

I am deeply thankful to God for being still able to send to you this brief annual message. For the year of 1969 the theme of my message is happiness and responsibility.

We all want to be happy, but we do not always succeed in our efforts to achieve that goal. One important reason is that we do not always know how to be happy. In fact we often have confused notions as to the things which bring about happiness. Let me tell you what I have learned about this subject from long experience.

The first lesson is that wealth, influence and authority are not the important factors which produce happiness. On the contrary they are often the cause of great distress and misery.

The second lesson is that we should not expect happiness to be presented to us on a silver plate. Happiness must be earned.

The third lesson is that happiness consists of the continuous process of working towards a noble goal, which involves challenges coupled with responsible activity. You may not achieve that goal fully, but as long as you are working diligently and hopefully towards that goal you will be happy. This is exactly the same as in a game of football, or in any other similar game. It is the actual playing which makes you happy. Naturally when you score a goal you are specially happy, but only for a moment. Continuous happiness requires a responsible and continuous struggle towards a goal. When one goal has been attained we must set for ourselves a new one.

The football analogy may be extended further. The more skilful you are at playing and the more skilfully you cooperate with the other members of the team the greater will be your enjoyment and happiness.

These lessons may be briefly summarized and applied in practice as follows:

- a. Select for yourself the trade or profession which you like and which you think can make your life useful, not only to yourself, but to others as well.
- b. Acquire the necessary skill in that trade or profession by thorough training. Then apply your skill with responsibility, with unlimited honesty and to the maximum of your ability.
- c. Under all circumstances cooperate with other people in the same or in other professions, making the happiness of others an important part of your general goal in life.

This is the prescription for happiness which I learnt from experience. It may not be very simple, but it always works. In closing I must greet each and every one of you and wish you success in whatever useful work you may be doing.
