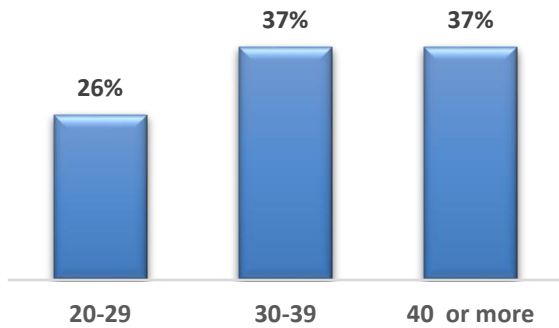

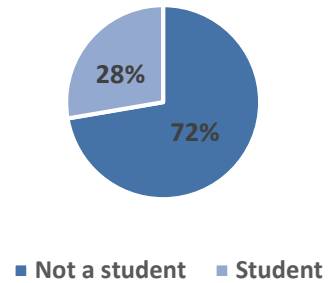

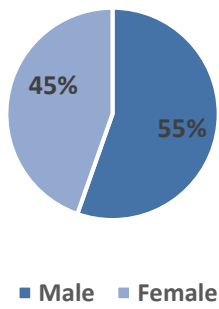
Age group of first author
