## Exchange Models for Semester Exchange

### 1. Summer Semester (recommended to cover April 1st – July 31st)

- Participate in regular weekly modules (see curriculum, each 6 ECTS)
- Participate in research conference and summer school (end of June, 3-6 ECTS)
- Individual topics can be covered in a Project Thesis (18 ECTS) which could be done in a research project or during an internship
- (optional) join block module, e.g. at KTU Kaunas

### 2. Winter Semester (recommended to cover Sep 15th – February 15th)

- Participate in regular weekly modules (see curriculum)
- Participate in “Dortmund International Winter School” (mid of November, 3-6 ECTS)
- Individual topics can be covered in a Project Thesis (18 ECTS) which could be done in a research project or during an internship
- (optional) join block module at UPV Bilbao (November) or KU Leuven (September)
- (optional) join block module Information Processing and Data Analytics (December)

**IMPORTANT:** scholarship is issued only for the period of lectures and exams. Scholarship will not be issued for the activity-free period (e.g. time after the last exam)

# Student Mobility for Summer Semester (general)

Date	Requirements for incomings
5 October	<p>Home University informs project lead at Fachhochschule Dortmund about the nominees and <b>register students in the mobility-online portal</b>.</p> <p>After the deadline: reviewing of nominees and conducting the interviews; Fachhochschule Dortmund accepts or rejects the nominees in the mobility-online portal.</p> <p>Selected students will have to complete their student registration on the mobility-online portal that will be provided in the email (see next deadline).</p>
<b>15 October</b>	<p>Before the interview students have to submit these documents to the Mobility Portal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transcript of records</li> <li>• Copy of your passport</li> <li>• CV</li> <li>• Prove of English language proficiency</li> </ul>
Begining of April	Arrival of students for the summer semester
July-August	Departure of students / End of summer semester



# Requirements for Students

- Formal requirements (meeting the deadline, completeness of documents)
- Good knowledge of the English language<sup>1</sup> (TOEFL-iBT 90, IELTS 6.5, or any other official certificate with minimum equivalent to CEFR B2<sup>2</sup>)
- Valid enrolment at home institution as a full-time student for the duration of the mobility (ask for certificate of enrolment in English)
- Max. of 12 months ERASMUS not reached, Min. of 90 days stay
- Mobility is implemented as one unit (no interruptions)
- Individual Achievements (see next slide)

<sup>1</sup>Evidence of sufficient English skills provided by a TOEFL-iBT test amounting to a minimum of 90 points. The evidence may also be provided by other test methods equivalent to the TOEFL-iBT test in accordance with the European Framework of Reference (e.g. IELTS with at least 6.5 points). In exceptional cases the evidence can be submitted by means of an equivalent certificate or test results demonstrating the relevant minimum requirements (equivalent to B2 [upper intermediate] of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)). An Expert Committee decides whether equivalence is demonstrated.

<sup>2</sup>The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Learning, Teaching, Assessment, abbreviated in English as CEFR, is a guideline used to describe achievements of learners of foreign languages across Europe

B2/Vantage or upper intermediate:

- Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in their field of specialization.
- Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party.
- Can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

# Selection Criteria

## Individual Achievements

The aim is to support cosmopolitan students who are interested in other cultures and who will be ambassadors of their home country within the ERASMUS-program.

- Matching of Master program at home institution (to provided programs by FH Dortmund) and preliminary course achievements
- *If performance is equal, deprived students should have priority*
- Personal interview (e.g. at home institution or skype call with FH Dortmund)
- Language proficiency of the national language of the guest county (basic knowledge)
- Internships
- CV
